**4.0 Presentation on California High Speed Rail Project**

J. Martinez and G. Arellano presented on this item. They provided an update on the project status for the Inland Empire section. A technical working group with city representatives was held last month to discuss the route, station stop options and related local issues. They have received specific feedback on plans and will schedule follow up consultations with cities and stakeholders to take place through September. Based on these meetings, staff will refine the alternatives for recommendations to the HSRA Board. There was discussion regarding community concerns with the route alignment, and the need to balance local land use impacts with train speed requirements. The Chair encouraged member cities to engage with the HSRA, if they have not already, to relay their land use concerns. The preliminary alternatives analysis report is anticipated to be released in September 2010 and the final report in January 2011. HSRA representatives will be invited to provide an update at the September Transportation Committee meeting after their follow up meetings with the cities.
